PARNU (ESTONIA) 6-13 maggio 2023

Another unforgettable event for 12 students of the "E. Fermi" of Catanzaro who returned from Estonia a week ago for the Erasmus+ "Water's Life" project, coordinated by Mrs Maria Prospero and with the participation of Mrs Antonella Loiacono and Mrs Giovanna Valeo.

All aware of the fact that they had had an uncommon opportunity, the guys

spoke about their moods. "Anxiety and apprehension were the feelings that characterized the days preceding the Sunday of departure, up until boarding the train. From then on we were too taken by the wonderful landscapes we had crossed in our Italy to think about the adventure we were starting." "The arrival at the airport in Rome, with all the boarding process, was particularly exciting because for many of us it was the first trip outside the national borders, even if being in company makes everything easier to deal with".

"The arrival in Parnu and the welcome of the students who had already been guests here with us was a real emotion for their availability, their kindness and the courtesy they reserved for us". "The lessons attended in the beautiful and historic building of the Co-Educational



Gymnasium of Parnu served to make us understand some differences with our school, while maintaining identical objectives in the study plans".

"During the excursions carried out to reach the project locations we saw enchanting natural landscapes, lots of uncontaminated nature, we met extremely helpful people, such as Mrs Tiina Saaritis and Mrs Eve Pop, and then the host families, absolutely welcoming and caring, who spoiled us all the time". "Probably a week is also a very limited time to deeply understand a culture so distant, geographically, from ours, but in any case it was enough to allow us to acquire confidence, awareness of being able to face daily life and its unexpected events." "To those who ask us how it went, we reply that we would return to Estonia immediately, and we think that from this we can



understand how important and pleasant this experience was for us, as a whole, from the arrival of 10 guys in Italy up to our return home." "If it is possible, we will participate in experiences of this type again, because we have realized what the ability to communicate in other languages means, for the growth of one's person and for the acquisition of one's own conscience, of one's own autonomy in 'deal with everyday life and difficulties, in short, a good life training for the future'. "So many emotions concentrated in one week are an excellent

stimulus for anyone to search for the many beautiful things that are around us and help a lot to overcome the bitterness of the end of this experience together with the desire to start again as soon as possible with a 'another adventure'.
